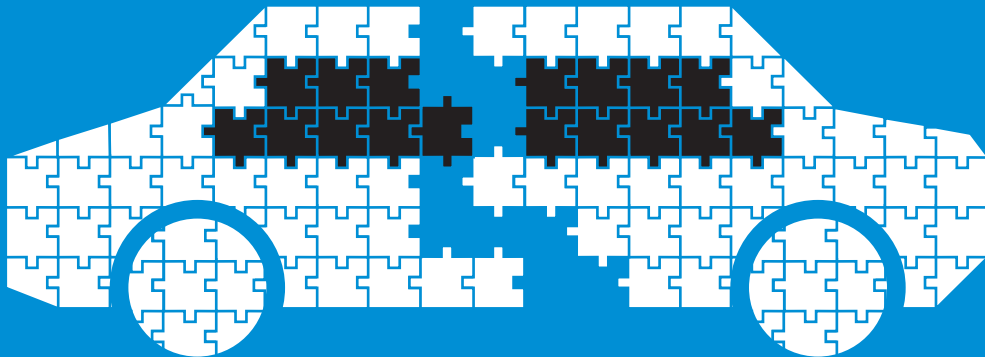

Buying a used car - *We'll help fill in the pieces*

When buying a car:

- Shop around and compare prices.
- Check if there is money owing on the car or if it has been stolen or declared written-off: search the Personal Properties Security Register www.ppsr.gov.au or call 1300 007 777. You will need the registration number (rego) and the Vehicle Identification Number (VIN).
- Have an inspection done by a licensed mechanic.
- Take it for a test drive.
- Check the car is registered at www.myrta.com

Tip: keep a copy of your registration, PPSR form and receipts where you can easily find them later.

Buyer Beware: you have less protection when you buy privately.
